Emptying Water From Pool (after heavy rain)

Emptying water is not part of any of our weekly maintenance services for a few reasons, the main one being the constraint of time. For many pool set ups, the process to let even 2 inches of water out, could take a few hours.

Almost every pool/ pool equipment set up is a little different from the next. The following are a few possible options for letting water out of your pool.

Option A: (if you have a Sand or DE filter)

- 1. Turn the backwash handle to "waste"
- 2. Turn on filter pump. (this process can lower about 1 inch per 30 min)
- 3. IF you have a DE filter- don't forget to add DE back in!

Option B: (for hose spigot/ T in the line) (most pools with a cartridge filter will have one)

- 1. Attach garden hose to hose spigot (this is usually along the plumbing between the pump and filter)
- 2. Open hose spigot all the way.
- 3. Turn filter pump on (either manually at yellow timer) or (most VS pumps are programmed to run for 2 hours by pressing the "Quick Clean" button). Using this garden hose method will usually take at least 2 hours to lower the water a couple inches.

Option C: (if you have a pressure cleaner such as a Polaris 280)

- 1. Place your cleaner (with hose still attached to wall) outside the pool, where you would like water to drain to.
- 2. Run cleaner.
